# My feet have DRY SKIN on the bottom that won't go away! Arrrggghh!

Dry skin on the bottom of the foot can be more than just dry skin. It often gets worse as the weather gets colder. The skin also gets dryer as we age because the sweat glands don't work as well. Also sometimes people that sweat too much get dry skin because the sweat can leach away the oils your skin needs to stay healthy.

The most important thing you can do if you have dry, scaly feet is find out what's causing it. We see many patients who have been treating the condition for years under the direction of a doctor (or not) and have never had a biopsy. A definitive diagnosis is only achievable by a biopsy. Without a biopsy, all treatments are just guesses. Guessing leaves the door open to unsatisfactory outcomes and frustration.

Sometimes the right diagnosis can provide a quick, permanent solution to the problem or provide a roadmap to successful long-term management of the problem. Sometimes just knowing what is wrong can be reassuring!

# From Fungus to Fabulous!

Fungus on the skin and/or nails is not attractive and can be upsetting. FUNGUS IS NOT A REFLECTION OF YOUR HYGIENE. Chronic fungal infections usually occur because of immune deficiencies. It usually takes more than one approach to get rid of fungal infections. Oral and topical medication for skin and nails along with treating shoes (to get rid of the organism in the shoes) are all part of the cure. For fungal nails, aggressive nail filing and laser therapy are very potent treatments. 
